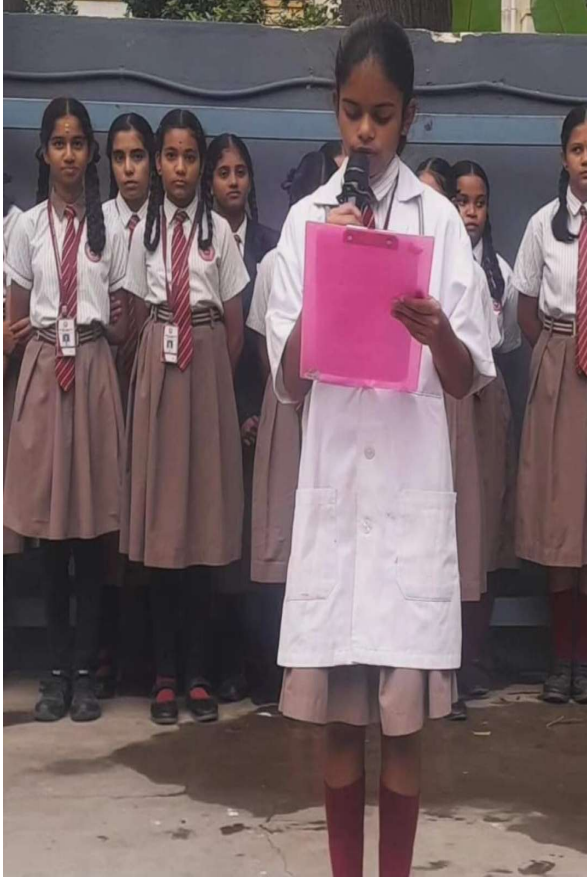


WORLD ZOOONOSES DAY

TALENT'S DAY CELEBRATION FOR KINDERGARTEN



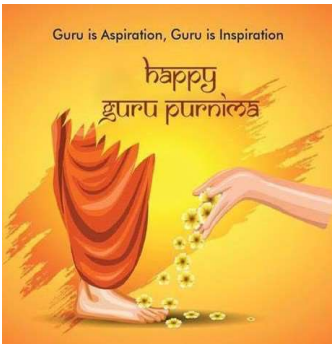

Tummy treat day

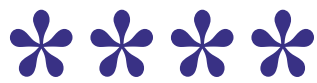
